Entry Fee: \$1 per entry, maximum \$10.00 per Section
Children's Section – Free Entry

General Rules:

- Exhibits must be delivered to the show grounds on Friday prior to the show between 4pm and 7:30pm or between 7am and 8.15am of show day. Please note if bringing items on Saturday morning you will be required to pay the entry fee to the show grounds.
- No entries will be accepted after 8.15am. Competitors to have left building by 8.30am
- All exhibits are entered at competitors' own risk.
- There will be security on the grounds on Friday evening and the building will be locked.
- All exhibits to be grown or made by the exhibitor.
- Photos must be from amateur photographers only in photo section or they will be disqualified.
- Children may enter the adult classes however they will be subject to entry fee.
- Presentation of ribbons and trophies will be at 3:15pm.
- Exhibits may only be removed from building after prize giving and prior to 5:00pm.
- Exhibits must be picked up by 5pm on Saturday or they will be disposed of.
- The hall will be closed for judging until approximately 11:30am.
- Classes may be split if necessary
- Sponsor's prizes may be awarded in place of prize money
- **Judge's decision will be final.**

Culinary – Jams & Preserves, etc. Section

- Any size jars. Removable lids on pickles etc. Cellophane jam covers on jam/jelly.
- No names on the jars please.
- All jars must be clean, labeled and dated.
- **All exhibits must be homemade.**

- 700 - Homemade Savoury Sauce, 1 bottle
- 701 - Homemade Sweet Dessert Fruit Sauce, 1 bottle
- 702 - Preserved Beetroot, 1 jar
- 703 - Chutney, any variety 1 jar
- 704 - Tomato Relish, 1 jar
- 705 - Pickle, any variety, 1 jar
- 706 - Lemon or Lime Honey, 1 jar
- 707 - Mint sauce, 1 bottle
- 708 - Preserved fruit, any type, 1 jar
- 709 - Marmalade, 1 jar
- 710 - Apple jelly, 1 jar
- 711 - Raspberry jam, 1 jar
- 712 - Any other berry jam, 1 jar
- 713 - Any other jam, stone fruit, 1 jar

Special Class:

- 714 - Gift basket or box (your choice of jams, pickles, preserves etc.) must not exceed 35 cm. Jars are to be labelled & dated, to be judged on contents & presentation

Produce Section

- To be judged on quality, unless otherwise stated.
- 5cm leaf stalk on root vegetables. Brassicas leaves left on except Broccoli.
- To be presented on a white disposable plate where possible.
- Vegetables and fruit must be washed.
- No commercially grown produce accepted.

- 716 - Potatoes - red, 3 for the table

- 717 - Potatoes - white, 3 for the table
- 718 - Potatoes, 3 large
- 719 - Carrots, 3
- 720 - Table tomatoes, 3
- 721 - Cocktail tomatoes, 3
- 722 - Rhubarb, 3 stalks (5cm leaf on)
- 723 - Strawberries, 3
- 724 - Any other fruit, 3
- 725 - Lettuce, 1
- 726 - Pods peas, 3
- 727 - Pods beans, 3
- 728 - Onions, 3
- 729 - Cabbage, 1
- 730 - Silver beet, 3 stems
- 731 - Courgette, 3
- 732 - Radish, 3
- 733 - Garlic, 3
- 734 - Broccoli or Cauliflower, 1
- 735 - Any other vegetable, 1
- 736 - Hen eggs, 3 single yolk, best quality and weight considered
- 737 - Bantam hen eggs, 3 single yolk, best quality and weight considered
- 738 - Collection of 6 vegetables, 1 of each variety
- 739 - Collection of herbs, 5 only in an Agee jam jar or similar
- 740 - Vegetable gift box or basket - not to exceed 50 cm, judged on contents & presentation, contents to be all grown by exhibitor
- 741 - Salad Selection- contents to be all grown by exhibitor, presented on pudding plate or similar

Special Class:

- 742 – Cut flowers arranged in a large Agee jar or similar – contents must be grown by exhibitor

Baking Section

- Each exhibit must be presented on a white disposable plate (side plate size please, other than Sponge Cakes, Cake, Pie or loaf). Please cover with a plastic bag.
- 744 - Pikelets, 3
- 745 - Oven Scones, 3
- 746 - Muffins, 3 of any variety, baked in tins, no paper
- 747 – Loaf of bread, 1 - white or brown
- 748 - Loaf, suitable for buttering
- 749 - Shortbread, 3 pieces
- 750 – Brownie, 3 pieces
- 751 - Cornflour Sponge, unfilled
- 752 - Sultana cake
- 753 - Square, 3 pieces any filling or topping
- 754 - Belgium biscuits, 3

- 755 - Biscuits, 3 of any type un-iced
- 756 - Biscuits, 3 of any type – with icing
- 757 - Decorated cupcakes, 3
- 758 – Chocolate Cake – **BLOKES ONLY**
- 759 – Pie with all the trimmings (sweet or savory), 1 – **BLOKES ONLY**

Special Class:

760 - Picnic Basket – must not exceed 35cm – will be judged on contents, originality, and presentation

Photography Section

- All photos to be 6” x 4” and unmounted.
- Photographs are not to have been exhibited at a previous Winton A&P Show.
- Photographs must be the work of the exhibitor. **Amateur photographers only.**
- Limit of 3 entries per exhibitor per class

Painting and Handcraft Section

- Paintings to be no larger than 50cm x 50cm.
- Paintings must be the work of an amateur artist.
- Handcraft article not to have been shown at a previous Winton A & P Show
- Quilts must be under 2m x 2m
- Pro-quilted quilts must state name of who quilted

- 775 - Painting- acrylic, oil, or watercolour
- 776 - Artwork - Any medium, unframed
- 777 - Framed Cross - stitch
- 778 - Patchwork quilt
- 779 - Patchwork article - other than quilt
- 780 - Handmade article not scheduled elsewhere e.g. Crochet, embroidery, or lace

- 781 - Hand knitted scarf
- 782 - Hand knitted baby garment - 3 or 4 ply wool
- 783 - Hand knitted garment – 8 or more ply wool
- 784 - Machine Stitched Garment
- 785 - Scrapbook page
- 786 - Christmas decoration – under 30 cm
- 787 - Handmade Christmas card
- 788 - Upcycled article – Something new from something old
- 789 - A creation made from recycled milk containers
- 790 - Woodwork article, 1
- 791 - Handmade article of any medium – no larger than 50 cm x 50 cm

Children's Section

- Ages as at 31 December 2019
- Must be the work of the exhibitor.
- **Food items to be on plastic plate covered in snap lock bag.**

Pre-School – 5 years and under

- 792 - Decorated wine biscuit
- 793 - A sand saucer (flowers)
- 794 - Vegetable & Fruit creation –on a plastic plate
- 795 - Play Dough Animal
- 796 - Pine cone critter
- 797 - Artwork Any Medium, A4 Size - **must be a farm scene**
- 798 - A Lego vehicle creation,

6 years to 9 years

- 799 - Birthday card - handmade, any medium A4 size folded
- 800 - Vegetable & Fruit Creation – on a plastic plate
- 801 - Lollycake, 3 pieces on a plastic plate
- 802 - Handmade article-e.g. Jewellery, papier Mache, metal or wood work
- 803 - Artwork, any medium A4 size, **must be a farm scene**
- 804 - Coloured photo print 6 x 4 - exhibitor must have taken photo
- 805 - Lego creation displayed on tray not to exceed 30cm

10 years to 13 years

- 806 - Greeting card - handmade any medium, A4 size folded
- 807 - Pizza, 1 – no larger than 20cm
- 808 - Handmade article of any medium - be creative
- 809 - Artwork Any Medium, A4 Size - **must be a farm scene**
- 810 - Coloured photo print 6 x 4 - must include an animal and be taken by exhibitor
- 811 - Kitset creation
